# Visa regime – any new difficulties?

Visa to UK is now very difficult as they move the visa office to BKK, so it takes long time and requests to provide all original documents to the visa office, which makes the parents of students worry of losing them while transporting these documents from Vietnam to Thailand.

IF the visa office make a mistake it will take them 28 days to correct it, so it affects so much to the time of departure of students as well as time to meet the course in the UK.

This year, VIECA co-organised with the Government Training University to conduct training for Education consultants to get official certificates to practise this profession.
